Sustainable Gift Wrapping



Now that you've chosen sustainable gifts, it's time to wrap them!

Step 1: Use what you have

• Try to use up all of the wrapping paper, gift bags, and ribbons that you already have instead of buying more. Gift bags are great for reusing!

Step 2: Start to incorporate some zero waste ideas

- Toppings: Top your presents with natural elements like clippings of pine trees, dried oranges, or cinnamon sticks
- Ribbons/bows: Wrap with natural twine instead of ribbon
- Wrapping Paper: Use brown packing paper you've saved throughout the year if it's wrinkled you can lightly iron it to smooth it out
- Paper Alternatives: Use fabric instead of paper. Here's a Marie Kondo <u>video</u> of the Japanese style of fabric wrapping called Furokashi. You can use a scarf, a swaddle, a tea towel, etc. and then the wrapping is part of the gift!

Step 3: Save the wrapping to reuse it next year!
